

Marco Milanese is Full Professor of Archaeology (Archaeological Methods, Medieval and Post-Medieval Archaeology) since 2003 in the University of Sassari, where he had previously taught since 1992 as Senior Lecture-Reader in Sassari, Genova and Pisa University (Associate Professor).

From 2014 to present (2018) he is Director of the Department of History, Human Sciences and Education. He teaches Post-Classical Material Culture and Archaeology in the Postgraduate School of Archaeology in the University of Cagliari and Sassari; he also taught Archaeology as Senior Lecture/Reader in the University of Pisa, Genova and Siena.

He has been Archaeology Inspector for the Soprintendenza Archeologica of Tuscany (Firenze) (1990-1992) and Curator of Archaeological Museum of Montelupo Fiorentino (1988-1990).

Director of PHD School on Archaeology, History and Human Sciences (University of Sassari) (2012-2015).

Director of Biddas Museum (*Museo dei Villaggi Abbandonati della Sardegna*), Sorso (Sassari).

Director of C.I.R.Te.Be.C. (Centro Interuniversitario per le Tecnologie Applicate ai Beni Culturali)

Member and Director of more than 250 archaeological excavations and topographical works in Liguria, Sardegna, Toscana, Lombardia, Abruzzo, Tunisia e Portogallo, concerning Medieval and Post-Medieval settlement and Material Culture.

Author of about 550 papers, books and published reports, he has founded the International Studies Journal "Archeologia Postmedievale" (1-1997/21-2017) and many others scientific series.
